Stuttering Prediction Instrument for Young Children Normed in 1984, pre-Illinois Longitudinal Studies Time since onset is asked but note scored Affective factors are scored Only 100 syllable sample Looks only at severity (number and length of SLDs) Doesn't count single-syllable whole-word repetitions

Subjective Screening of Stuttering severity, locus of ...

The screening of the areas of severity, locus of control and avoidance can indicate if further evaluation is needed The severity rating can be correlated with such instruments as the percent syllables stuttered (%SS), duration, or the Stuttering Severity Instrument, third edition (SSI-3) (Riley, 1994)

School-Age Stuttering Therapy: A Practical Approach

a) The Stuttering Severity Instrument (SSI; Riley, 2009) rates severity based on frequency, duration, and observed physical concomitants b) The Test of Childhood Stuttering (TOCS; Gillam, Logan, & Pearson, 2009) for ages 4 to 12 examines four different speaking situations 4 ...

The Assessment of Cluttering Severity in Research and ...

The need to measure cluttering severity comprehensively; cluttering is not a simple unidimensional fluency problem SSI-4: a successful model for measuring stuttering severity SSI a successful balance between being comprehensive and practical Cluttering should ...
