Assessment and Treatment of Voice Disorders

- Voice disorders are related to laryngeal and upper airway structure and function
- Voice disorders are defined as any deviation in pitch, loudness, variability or vocal quality relative to a child's age, gender and cultural background
- An estimated 6-23% of school-aged children experience voice disorders

What is voice quality? Voice quality can refer to any of the suprasegmental properties of speech that result from how your vocal apparatus is configured - Example: nasality Usually, though, we use “voice quality” to refer specifically to the properties of speech affected by stuff inside your larynx
